

## CAMPUS PARKING AT LEHIGH

Like most college campuses, parking can be difficult and challenging due to a scarcity of spaces, so being well-informed is the key for everyone (even students/staff). Ticketing WILL occur if signs aren't followed, but three large parking garages have greatly alleviated visitor needs. Here's a quick pic summary to help you navigate on campus:

**1.) ZOELLNER GARAGE:** closest to the Gym: **(6 am - 11 pm; 7 days/wk)**: all cars are charged a \$1 entry fee (automated; insert bill). Permits not required. Parking sometimes unavailable Sundays **before 11 am**(cleaning). Fastest way to the gym is out the **back stairway** (2<sup>nd</sup> floor), turn **right** behind the building 150 ft, then intersect a large steep stairway – go up the steps, then cross thru the back parking lot to the far side of Taylor Gym. Wrap around to the left, then walk downhill on Taylor to the gym entrance (sorry, the back door is always locked for security reasons).



Taylor Gym is above (South of) Zoellner about 100 yds (as the crow flies)but it's a zig-zag route.



Easy to get fooled for 1<sup>st</sup> visit – cars enter to the **LEFT** of the center post (“Entrance”)

**2.) CAMPUS SQUARE GARAGE:** enter from the south side (on Asa Drive); restricted to Faculty/Staff from 6 am-4 pm. Visitor parking is allowed 7 days/wk at 52 metered spaces, including two for handicapped, on the lower level of the garage. Fee: \$.50/hr from 6 am to midnite. and midnight. Permits needed for access controlled areas of this garage.

3.) **ALUMNI MEMORIAL BLDG GARAGE:** This “furthest” from Taylor large garage is actually the easiest and prettiest path to approach – since it’s a completely straight and flat walkway dead East from the Alumni Memorial Building, just a 400 yard walk to the gym entrance.

Open 24 hrs/day with 6 levels and exits at both top and bottom; has elevator, handicapped parking, metered spaces for visitors – a popular option for fans attending Sat/Sunday home duals.

To get to Taylor Gym, simply walk down to the ground floor and out the front of the garage; turn right immediately and take the walkway that wraps around to the right of the Alumni Memorial Bldg (pictured above left), then turn right onto a walkway straight away from the bldg; take one short left and wrap around the Flagpole Center Green to its left.

This is how your goal will look as you pass the Flagpole, with the University Center above to the right and the Asa Packer Chapel on your left – then a spectacularly renovated University Library just beyond the Flagpole Green:
